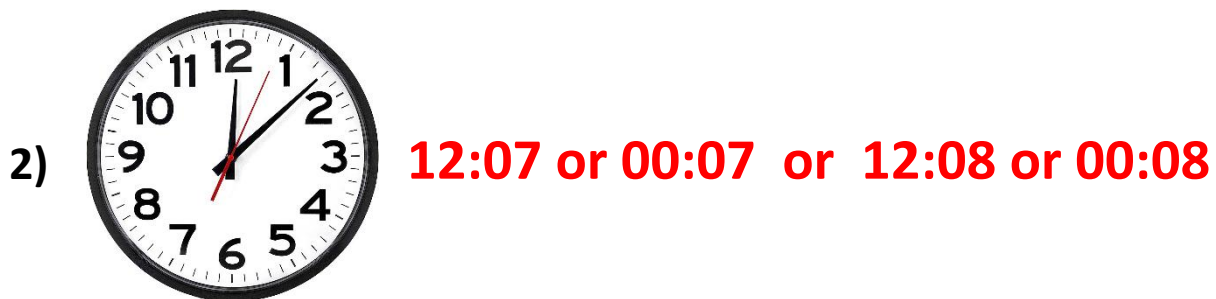
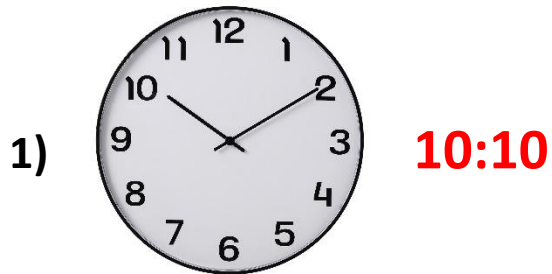

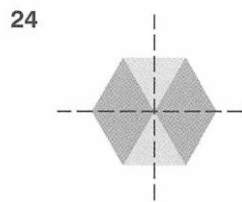

1) **A**

Each series square rotates 90 degrees anticlockwise.

2) **A**

Both the large white shape and the black shape gain an extra side in each series square.

3) **D**

An extra circle is added in each series square.

The colour of the circles alternates between white and grey.

4) **D**

In each series square, the next diamond on the right moves to the front of the figure.

Section 4 — Reflect the Figure

1) **C**

Option A has been rotated 180 degrees. Option B has the wrong shading. In option D, there are only three shapes.

2) **D**

In option A, the submarine has no windows. In option B, the submarine has not been reflected and the black shading has moved. Option C has the wrong shading.

3) **C**

In option A, the white arrow has not been reflected and the grey arrow has rotated 180 degrees. Option B has the wrong shading. In option D, the grey arrow is in the wrong position.

4) **B**

In option A, only the top section has been reflected. Option C has the wrong shading. Option D is a downwards reflection.
